
Similarly, businesses are increasingly looking for employees who can not only add value to their organisation, but who can accelerate them forwards on an ever more connected world stage. Helping your

Learning With Pamoja



Students join a global classroom of up to 30 students from all around the world and are given access to course content through our learning platform, ManageBac. Content is broken down into weekly lessons featuring assignments, activities, and opportunities to collaborate.

Pamoja Online Courses are available 24/7. Student engagement is primarily asynchronous utilising collaboration tools to engage with peers who are located worldwide. Teachers use the same tools to support learning and provide live lesson opportunities via Zoom. Each student actively participates in an online learning community where interactions across time zones are supported.


Prepare Your Child for University

Pamoja Online Courses are designed to cover the academic content required by the IB while providing the structure for students to develop self-motivation and self-regulation skills. Both are important skills that will enable your child to hit the ground running in university and work.

According to research carried out by the University of London's Institute of Education with students using Pamoja Online Courses:

- 100% of participants said that, prior to university, they had gained experience in a range of online learning tools that they are now using as part of their university learning
- Many indicated that the pre-university experience of online learning provided 'rehearsal space', allowing students to develop their approaches to study, including note-taking, information searching and communicating online (with peers and teachers) before starting university





With a 1,511 strong cohort, the Class of May 2022 achieved an average IB grade of 5.23, exceeding the IB world average. Given the non-selective admissions process Pamoja utilises, these results are outstanding. Grade predictions made by our highly experienced faculty were within 0.04 of a grade when compared with IB awarded final grades. This proximity demonstrates just how well our teachers know our students.

How are Students Supported?



Our teachers have a wealth of experience and subject expertise and are trained in digital learning strategies. Your child can contact them anytime via our online learning platform, ManageBac.

Technology allows our teachers to accurately monitor your child's progress and provide support at the point it is needed most. However, we know how important it is to ensure that your child is fully supported both online and in their schools. That's why we also have a Site-based Coordinator (SBC) in place at each IB school; a face-to-face point of contact and existing member of the school's staff, who offers additional guidance. Our dedicated Academic and School Services teams assist your child's teacher and SBC, ensuring they are fully equipped to give your child the highest level of support.

Case Study

Amelia is an IB graduate who moved to Gjøvik videregående Skole in Norway from Germany. She studied Business Management HL and French ab initio with Pamoja Online Courses.

When I unexpectedly moved from my international school in Germany to a small Norwegian high school in Norway, I realised that Pamoja would be the only way I could study some of the subjects I originally wanted to study in the IB Diploma Programme.

Each course is structured in a way that you have to actively take part in your learning. I have been able to dive into topics in a way that is starkly different than a traditional classroom. This has resulted in the development of both my research and self-directed learning skills.

The biggest challenge for me was managing my time effectively. I felt like I struggled to adjust to the fact that my classroom was not a traditional classroom rather, it was a classroom which I carried around with me every day and could access from anywhere and at any time. Once I realised this, my learning improved greatly because I could structure my day in a way which suited my school timetable best. This resulted in less stress because I did not feel the pressure to understand something immediately.

The level of student collaboration and the international nature of tasks in both of my courses have enabled me to feel connected on a global scale. The collaborative environment Pamoja presents has been an amazing experience because it has allowed me to meet people from all over the world from places such as Indonesia, USA, Austria, and even some others living in Norway. Staying connected amidst a global pandemic has definitely proven to be a challenge, yet, in my Pamoja courses, it felt like I was part of a wider, international community.

So far, I have seen tremendous self-growth in the sense that I have learnt important skills relating to time-management and organisation. These skills will help me in other IB courses as well as in my university years and beyond. The Pamoja courses have presented me with the opportunity to connect real life experiences and knowledge with the required coursework. Rather than viewing learning as a chore, it is now something which I look forward to each week.

"Amy's marks have improved significantly from where she began to where she is now, and we're all really pleased. Before she started she really didn't like French. She had this idea that she was absolutely useless - she couldn't speak properly, couldn't pronounce the words properly, she would never be able to do this. I don't know how Pamoja did it, but she is now considering Eastern Europe as a place to study, and French would then be her language that she'd carry on studying alongside medicine. She's willing to go for it and learn more French - it's boosted her confidence, she doesn't stress about the pronunciation and the vocabulary anymore."




Students can register via their Plan Worksheet
